

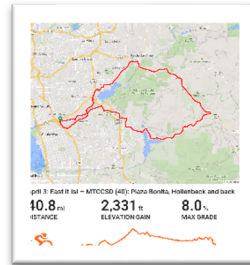
**April 4: East it is! – MTCCSD (40): Plaza Bonita, Hollenbeck and back**

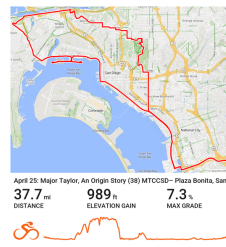
**April 11: Major Taylor, An Origin Story (38) MTCCSD– Plaza Bonita, San Diego Volodrome, City Tacos**

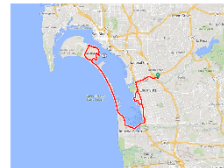
**April 18: Bellbottoms and Dixie Cups (38+) MTCCSD: Special Access Ride. RSVP Required.**

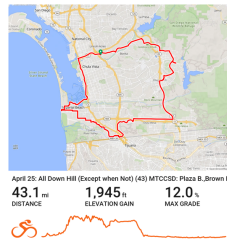
**April 25: All Down Hill (Except when Not) (43) MTCCSD: Plaza B., Brown Field, Las Americas, IB**

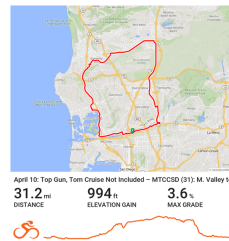
**May 2: Top Gun, Tom Cruise Not Included – MTCCSD (31): M. Valley to Miramar**
