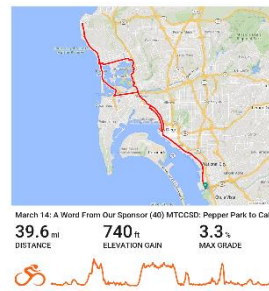

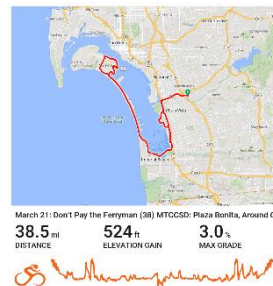
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March 21: Don't Pay the Ferryman (38) MTCCSD: Plaza Bonita around Coronado and Back

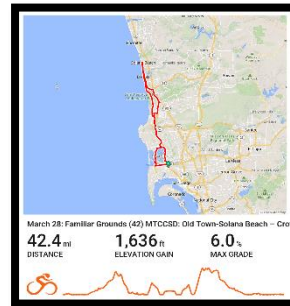
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March 28: Familiar Grounds (42) MTCCSD: Old Town-Solana Beach – Crown Point (42)
